Location: R&R Peace Centre in Bkarzla, Akkar Region, Lebanon

Who we are:

Relief & Reconciliation International AISBL is a non-profit organisation based in Belgium that is combining peacebuilding with humanitarian help for those affected by the Syrian crisis. Our Lebanese branch started operations in 2013 with the opening of a first Peace Centre for the youth in Akkar, a region in the North of Lebanon next to the Syrian border. More than 150 international volunteers have lived and worked there so far, forming a small community of international solidarity and providing services especially in the field of education, psychosocial support and peacebuilding. Our international volunteers are assisting our local Lebanese and Syrian staff members in the implementation of our programme lines.

What we are looking for:

We are launching a call to join us as long-term Volunteer Assistant for at least three months (renewable). Living and working at the R&R Peace Centre, our Volunteer Assistants will gain a unique opportunity to learn how to better serve those affected by the Syrian crisis. In daily direct contact and under the guidance of those we serve, our international volunteers are becoming first-hand witnesses of the biggest refugee crisis since the end of the Second World War and hence ambassadors of the Syrian people after their return home. During their stay at the R&R Peace Centre, they will help us implement services in the fields of education, psychosocial support and peacebuilding as specified below.

Our Lebanese branch is looking for experienced men and women who are willing to assist in the fields of foreign language teaching (French and English), project development and communications. Please find below the precise terms of reference for each of these positions. Volunteer assistants are required to stay at the R&R Peace Centre for the entire duration of a term. If you wish to stay for a shorter period of time (between 2 and 6 weeks), please think about a proposal to serve as Project Volunteer as advertised on our website. R&R Lebanon operates in sensitive regions of Lebanon, where there may be security concerns of varying severity. We therefore ask that volunteers demonstrate an awareness of their environmental and cultural surroundings. Volunteers are expected to follow the principles and rules established by our local branch. At the R&R Peace Centre, we are putting particular emphasis on the concept of hospitality and spiritual solidarity, which entail respect for each person's convictions or beliefs.

Costs: Volunteers are asked to pay for their own travel to and from Lebanon and for their travel insurance. The following costs are covered by R&R International for the duration of their term:

- Accomodation and meals (shared bed-rooms and basic food supplies, at least one warm meal per day)
- Transport within Lebanon related to all programme activities

Under the auspices of a local Steering Committee, we have established a first Peace Centre in Akkar: a house that serves as a safe place for young people from all confessions and groups, Syrians and Lebanese, where international and local staff help to develop skills and to treat the war trauma of the youth, also providing material aid where needed. R&R Lebanon has no affiliation to any government, party or confession; it is born out of the spirit of Christian-Muslim friendship, open for all. At the R&R Peace Centre, we put special emphasis on the concept of spiritual solidarity.

Position profile

Along with our Lebanese educational staff, three international **Volunteer Teaching Assistants** will implement the activities contained in the Educational Programme Line related to the teaching of foreign languages: 2 assistants for teaching French and 1 assistant for teaching English to both Syrian refugees and Lebanese host communities.

Volunteer Assistants will be accommodated at the R&R Peace Centre in Akkar. They are supposed to be the heart and soul of the Peace Centre, implementing R&R Lebanon's overarching vision to build bridges of understanding between different communities, to raise awareness for the Syrian refugee crisis and to yield international solidarity for those affected. Teaching activities will hence be complemented by regular extracurricular activities and outreach visits with different communities present in the Akkar region, as well as by communication with the outside world.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- -Support the field staff of R&R Lebanon in the implementation of R&R Lebanon's vision and mandate in the Akkar region of Lebanon, both related to Syrian refugees and Lebanese host communities;
- -Maintain and develop the R&R Peace Centre as an open house to the youth of all communities present in the region and as a place of spiritual hospitality and exchange;
- -Maintain and develop relationships based on mutual respect and trust with all communities present in the region through regular outreach visits to refugee camps and host communities;

- -Assist our local teachers and teaching volunteers, amongst them Lebanese and Syrians, in the implementation of school support classes and the development of innovative pedagogical tools at the R&R Peace Centre and in other teaching locations nearby;
- -Plan and implement supplementary French and/or English language classes to Syrian refugees and affected Lebanese at the R&R Peace Centre and in other teaching locations nearby;
- -Participate in the development and implementation of extracurricular activities such as recreational activities for Syrian and Lebanese children/youth: arts and skills workshops, etc.;
- -Participate in the development and implementation of life-skill modules, such as non-violent action, computer literacy, hygiene, environmental awareness, etc.;
- -Support the implementation of R&R Lebanon's communication strategy by producing updates from the R&R Peace Centre to our volunteer blog and social media sites;
- -Contribute to the creation of a positive image and overall credibility of R&R Lebanon, notably through the application of R&R Lebanon's mandate, ethics, and values;

- -Experience with recreational activities: sports, performing and/or plastic arts, or others, desirable;
- -Strong interpersonal skills; comfortable navigating multi-cultural environments;
- -Ability to work as part of a team as well as under own initiative;
- -Ability to work well under pressure and meet tight deadlines;
- -Ability to obtain a visa for a volunteer stay in Lebanon;
- -International driving licence an asset.

International volunteers will be accommodated at the R&R Peace Centre in Akkar. They are supposed to be the heart and soul of the Peace Centre, implementing R&R Lebanon's overarching vision to build bridges of understanding between different communities, to raise awareness for the Syrian refugee crisis and to yield international solidarity. The development of new activities, such as vocational training modules, spiritual solidarity events or youth clubs, will hence be complemented by administrative tasks, regular outreach visits and communication with the outside world.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities
